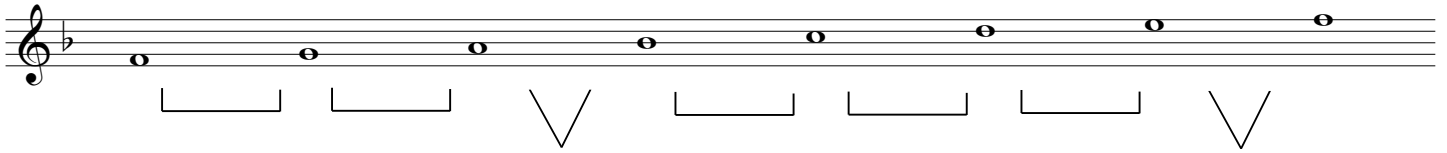


# Major/Minor

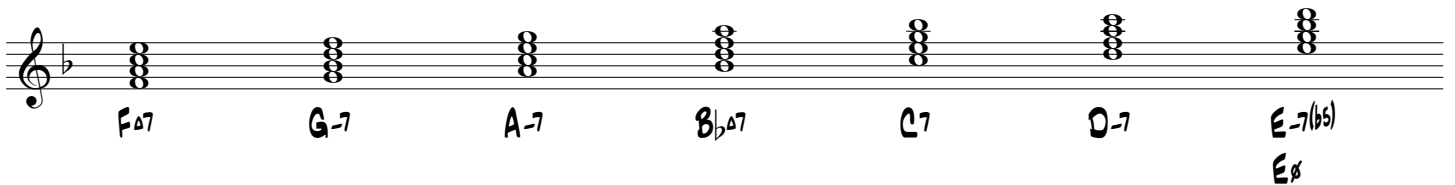
Difference Major/minor: third  
 Major 2 intervals (major third)  
 Minor 1 1/2 interval (minor third)



Steps:



<b>I</b>	<b>II</b>	<b>III</b>	<b>IV</b>	<b>V</b>	<b>VI</b>	<b>VII</b>
major	minor	minor	major	major	minor	(minor)

<b>Minor:</b>	<b>II, III, VI</b>	<b>Symbol:</b>	<b>-7</b>	<b>G-7 A-7 D-7</b>
	<b>VII</b>	<b>Symbol:</b>	<b>-7<sub>b</sub>5</b>	<b>E-7<sub>b</sub>5</b>
